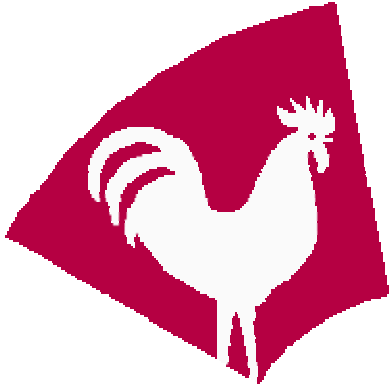

Every year the board signs a letter of agreement with the Upper Room. This letter states that we will follow the "model" that the Upper Room has established. Over the years the Central Ohio Emmaus Community has changed some things about the weekend, resulting in us moving a little away from the "model". Over the next year we will be trying to get back in line with the model set forth by the Upper Room. Although these changes will be apparent to the current community members, we must remember that the new Pilgrims coming into the community will not even know that there were changes made. It will be the current community members that will see the changes and therefore may have issues. We have to remember that the "Walk to Emmaus" is for the pilgrims and not for us.
