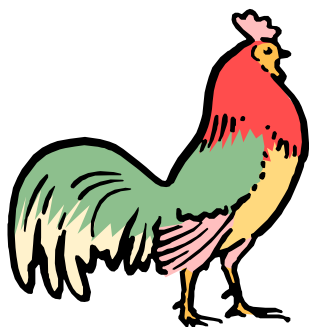
I would encourage all of you to remind yourselves that the key word is "ALWAYS" as we serve our Lord in our 4th Days.

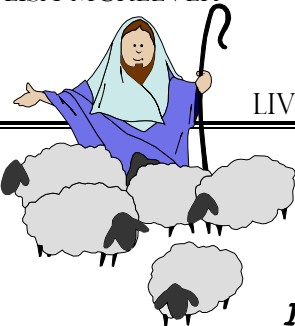

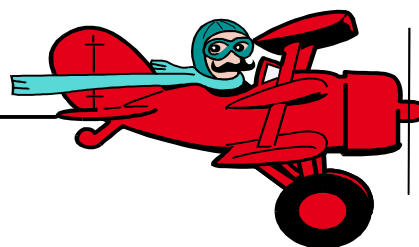
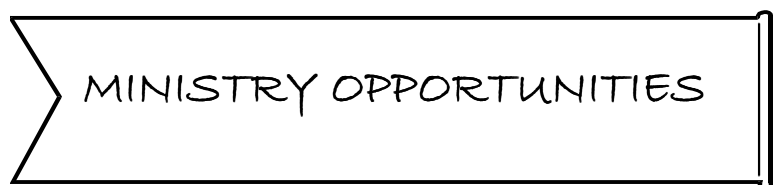
